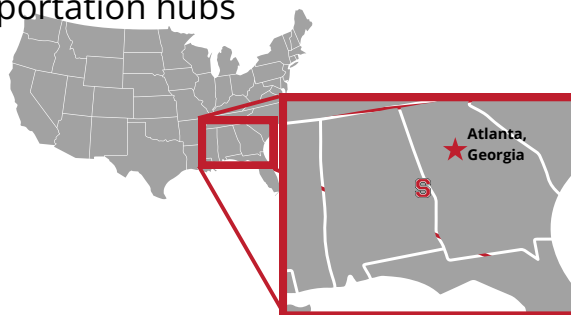

How to Apply

Step 1:

Step 2

Submit your online application with the following required documents:

High school transcripts, Two teacher recommendations, Proof of financial ability, Passport photo page, English proficiency test

Step 3

Complete a Zoom interview with Springwood International Admissions.
